
Curriculum News

Owls and Herons



Welcome back to the final term of the academic year! It's going to be a busy one with sports week and sports day.

Overview

Literacy

The children will learn to write recounts in first and third person including writing a diary entry.
Poetry will also be studied.

During sports week we will find out about the Olympics.

Numeracy

Addition and Subtraction: formal written methods; Measures (area, perimeter & time); Written methods for

division; Fractions Shape; angles & co-ordinates

Science

Animals including Humans/ Electricity.

We will finish off learning about the digestive system & teeth, before moving on to electricity. We will learn about safety and circuits.

RE

In RE the children will continue studying the topic of forgiveness within religious and non-religious practices. They will be looking in depth at the Jewish festival of Yom Kippur.

Design and Technology

We will be designing and making using levers and linkages. Children will look at Roman catapults and then design & make a simple, small version of one.

History

Romans:

Why did Claudius invade Britain in AD43? What effect did the invasion have on the Britain's? Why did Boudica revolt? What is the Roman legacy?

Computing

The children will continue to develop their coding skills using Scratch.

PSHF

The children will think about their responsibilities, rights and duties (home, school and the environment), about resolving differences - agreeing and disagreeing and about being part of a community.
