

Attendance at school

What YOU must do:

- Telephone the school before 9.00am each day of your child's absence.
- Advise the school office in advance, of any medical appointments and bring or email in appointment cards/letters.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, consider sending them in as they often perk up on arrival.
- Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so we can help!

What WE will do:

- Check your child's attendance every day.
- Phone home to discuss your child's attendance with you.
- Invite you into school for attendance meetings if we are concerned.
- If we cannot establish a reason for absence, then we may make a welfare home visit.
