- Wears a named full school uniform
- Ensure they wear a PE kit on days they have PE
- Let the school know of any worries or concerns that may be affecting my child's learning behaviour, or ability to undertake home learning
- Treat all staff and members of the school community with respect
- Encourage a positive attitude towards my child's education and our school. If I have any concerns, I will discuss them with the school
- Read all relevant information sent in correspondence as this gives me important details of relevant policies, meetings, activities, events and open days
- Let the school know of any changes to the medical needs for my child
- Be responsible for making payments on time

- Ensure the school is aware of who is collecting my child
- Support and work with the school to ensure that the behaviour management policies of the school are maintained
- Provide a note, email or telephone call if my child is absent from school
- Ensure that if the school contacts you for your child to be collected because of illness, that this is done immediately to save the child from discomfort
- If my child does not have a school meal, I will provide a healthy lunch (and optional piece of fruit as a snack). I will ensure all food sent into school is nut-free
